Attended funeral (Funeral Directors charges only) £3,365

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all the necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£1,400
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the Funeral Directors premises) in the Funeral Directors care	£300
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the Funeral Directors branch premises	£500
Providing a suitable coffin - this will be made from oak veneer with nameplate and handles	£615
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the Funeral Director in hours (where viewing is requested by the customer)	No fee
At a date and time you agree with the Funeral Director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the Funeral Directors premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£550

Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (Funeral directors charge only)	£3,365
Cremation (Funeral Directors charge plus the cremation fee) ²	£1,550

Fees you must pay

For an Attended or Unattended funeral burial, the burial fee. 1 In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	£618 - £1465
For a new grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended Cremation funeral, the cremation fee. 2 In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	£1000 - £1,220

Additional Funeral Director products and services

This Funeral Director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

Additional mileage (price per mile)	£1.75
Additional Transfers of the deceased persons body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) (price per transfer, additional costs may apply)	£400
Collection and delivery of ashes	£110
Embalming	£265
Funeral Officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of Religion etc.)	£230
Services supplied outside of normal office hours	Prices on request

The Funeral Director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you can choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing one.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay a doctors fee as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
